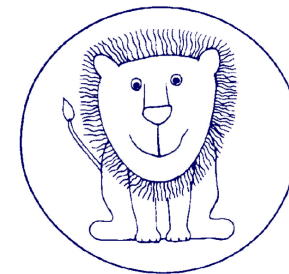


Linslade Lower School
