Topic 1

Eco-Schools Topic	Litter
Aim Write a short explanation of what you hope to achieve.	To ensure the school is litter free and is a suitable habitat for wildlife.

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Topic 2

Eco-Schools Topic	Waste and marine
Aim	To investigate ways to waste as little as possible and cut down on single use plastic. To recycle as many things as possible in school to have less impact on the environment.
Action(s)	Recycle batteries- Join the Big Battery Hunt. Encourage families to bring in used batteries to recycle. https://www.bigbatteryhunt.co.uk/ Remind families to recycle plastics in school through terracycle Have a Recycle and Plastic Free Week- June 2025. Encourage families to use reusable pots for snacks. Recycle any plastic that is used. Inform children and families of ways to recycle. Eco group make a piece of art work out of recycled materials to display in school during Recycle and Plastic Free Week- June 2025
Informing & Involving	Letters to families about the Big Battery Hunt in January 2024. Letter to families about Recycle and Plastic Free Week and children to design posters. Inform staff through the staff bulletin
Monitoring & Evaluation	Monitor the amount of single use plastic before and after the Recycle and Plastic Free Week and see if a change has been made.



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Topic 3

Eco-Schools Topic	Biodiversity
Aim	To encourage biodiversity in the school grounds
Action(s)	Ask the PTA for £250 to purchase wildflower seeds and hedgehog hideaways Make bug hotels around the edge of the field. Position hedgehog hideaways in quiet areas Sow the wild flower seeds in spring Let the wild flowers self-seed
Informing & Involving	Inform children in assemblies and class time Inform parents via the newsletter Inform staff through the staff bulletin
Monitoring & Evaluation	Feedback from eco groups, staff and parents
