Have your circumstances changed? You could be entitled to free school meals.

If you think you may be eligible for free school meals please take a look at the Central Bedfordshire website and make an application. Families of children who are entitled are receiving supermarket vouchers during the holidays, discounts off club and trips and visits.



### Parentline Bedfordshire



Parentline is a secure and confidential text service for parents and carers of those aged 0-19. It offers advice and support on a range of issues such as weaning, sleep and emotional health or how to make an appointment with a health visitor.
