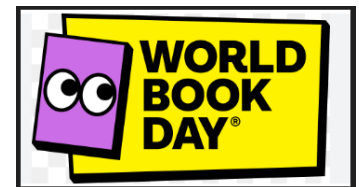

We are pleased to announce that we are offering health clinics for parents/carers.

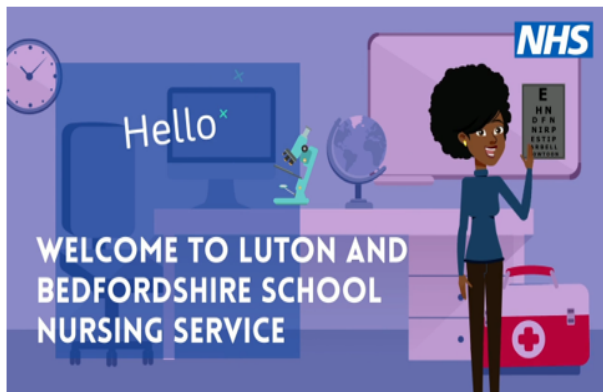
You can make an appointment via the school or if you prefer, just drop in for a chat.

These clinics will be staffed by your school nursing team at your child's school.


All are welcome to attend.
