Restorative Practice
Building relationships is key.
When we fall out with someone, we talk. We talk to find a solution to fix the problem. This way we learn.

At Linslade Lower School we develop children's character through our Behaviour Curriculum. In order to build character, we define the behaviours and habits that we expect students to demonstrate. The curriculum is taught explicitly during the first week in Autumn term alongside the traditional National Curriculum subjects. The children of Linslade Lower School learn about the Behaviour Curriculum, and unpick what it means to show each of the areas, in assembly and in their classes. This common language helps us all to behave in a positive way.

The children have been really successful in the adoption of the curriculum and in showing positive behaviour!
