Lost Property

Our lost property basket is overflowing with items that cannot be returned to children because they are not named.

We would ask that during this half term you **ensure your child's clothes and equipment are named** and that names written on earlier in the year are still legible.

As well as clothes, PE kit and shoes; water bottles, lunch boxes and sun hats need naming.



Summer Term Uniform

Please ensure you have named all items of uniform.

- Grey trousers (long or short) or pinafore dress or skirt
- Pale blue polo shirt or blouse
- Plain navy blue cardigan or jumper or sweatshirt
- White, grey or navy socks
- Suitable, sturdy black shoes with laces or a bar. Not trainers. Children may bring in an additional pair of trainers to wear if they play football at playtimes.
- Girls: Blue and white gingham check dress for the summer



Eco Week



Next week the children will be taking part in Eco Week. West End in School will be coming in on Monday to deliver a workshop called Our World Our Future to children in Years 1 to 4.

Each afternoon the children will be learning about how to Reduce, Reuse and Recycle and how to care for the environment.

School closes at 3.30pm on Thursday 21st May for half term. Friday 22nd May is an INSET Day for staff who will be undertaking staff training. School will reopen to pupils on Monday 1st June.



Sun Safety

In-line with our Sun Protection Policy we ask that parents-

- Ensure their child(ren) are equipped with a suitable sun hat in school every day. Please name the hat.
- Apply sun cream in the morning before school. Some sun creams provide protection for longer periods of time and do not need re applying.
- Children in Early Years are outside for longer periods of time than those in main school. If you wish for your child to re-apply sun cream themselves during the day please send in a roll on type sun cream. These will be kept in the classroom and accessed with support by a member of staff. The children will apply it themselves. Please label the pot. (e.g. before outside play and learn on days when the UVR rating is high)
- Children in Main School are outside for shorter period of time. They have a 20 minute play time at 10.30am, a 30 minute playtime at lunchtime and PE outside once a week. If you wish for your child to re-apply sun cream themselves during the day please send in a roll on type sun cream. The children will apply it themselves. These will be kept in the classroom and accessed with support by a member of staff. Please label the pot. (e.g. before PE on days when the UVR rating is high)
- We recommend that sunscreens have a minimum Sun Protection Factor (SPF) 30, be 'broad-spectrum' (to provide both UVA and UVB protection) and, if labelled with a UVA star rating, carry a minimum of 4 stars.
- Our school will provide spare sun hats on days when the UV rating is high and children have forgotten their own.
- Children may bring in sunglasses to wear outside. These must be clearly named.
- Children must bring in a named water bottle filled with water every day.
- School will not take any responsibility for the loss or damage of these items.

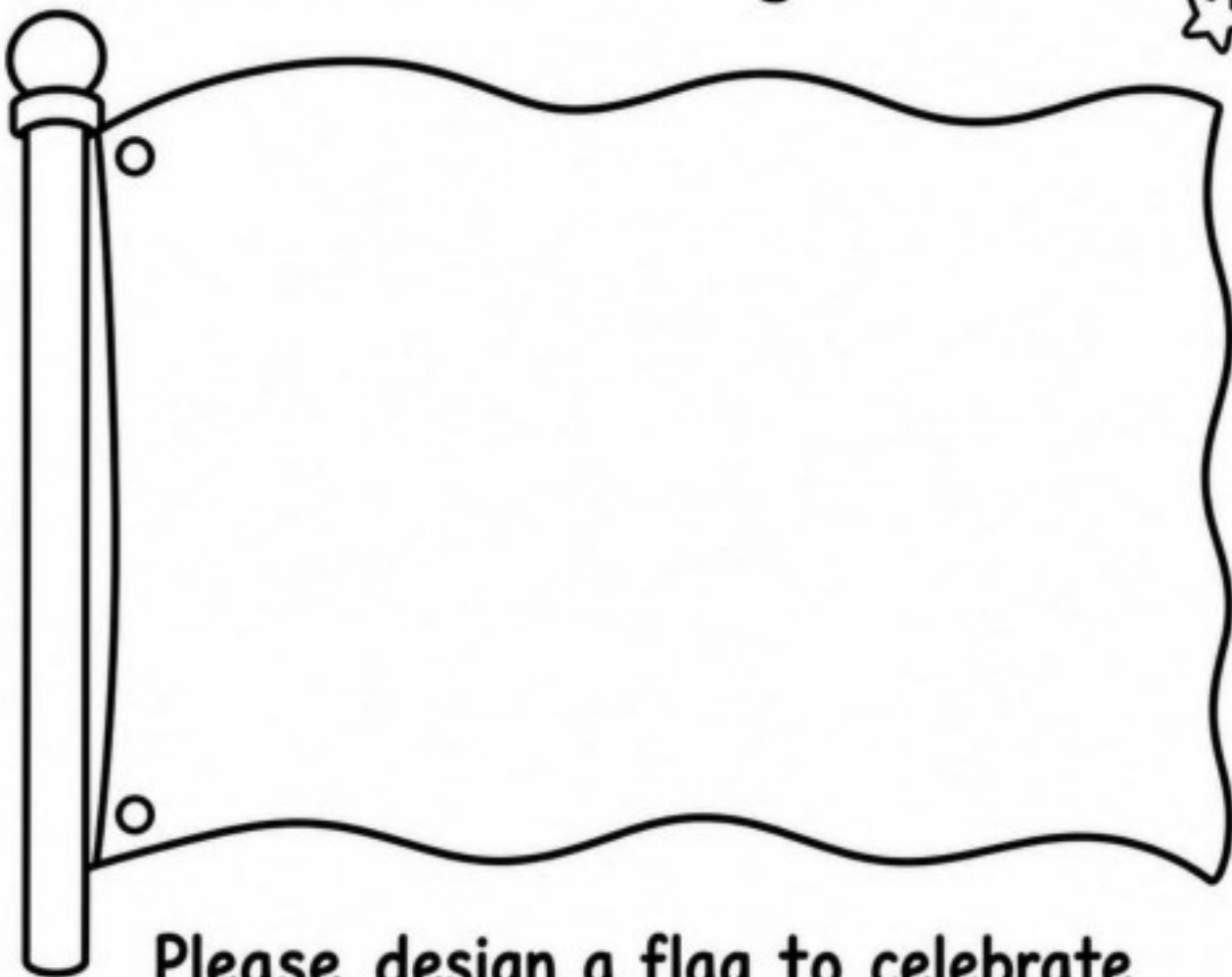
